

Vendor Checklist:

- Register on-line by filling out **both** of these forms (by June 7 for early bird pricing):

You may complete the enclosed paperwork instead but fill them out legibly and completely.
- All vendors must weigh down their tents. Get your weights together now so that they are ready for your first market this season.
- **All items** sold at the market must come from Colorado or a surrounding state. All crafted items must be made by the vendor or a direct family member. No buying stuff from a warehouse or overstock store and reselling at the Market. We aren't running a flea market or hosting a garage sale.
- All produce must be sold by growing farmer or purchased directly from growing farmer.
- Vendors will be placed by Market staff. The staff is committed to providing adequate placement for all the vendors not just for some of the vendors.
- Vendors can again donate goods to the Food Bank at the end of every market day. We will also have food drives during the season as a thank you to the Food Bank for allowing us to use their space to store our Market gear.
- If you are interested in being a market underwriter, I have included a form for that as well. This is a great way to help support the market and advertise your farm/ business. You can also share the form with other business owners who might want to help support our market.
- The Health Department has reminded me that anyone who sells prepared food must show proof of completion of a Food Safety Handling Class every 2 years. If you did not take a class last year, you must take one this year. **You will need to bring your proof of completion to your first market or you may not sell your cottage foods or other prepared foods until Market staff has this in hand.**
